I look forward to speaking with you and Gabe today after 2 pm. Based upon our short conversation today, we will

- 1. Withdraw the variance request to eliminate fencing. Instead, the AST areas will be fenced with gates, just like a tank battery. We understand the OCD concern regarding doing more than the stairwell chains, etc. to restrict human access to the ASTs
- 2. With respect to the side slope variance, you may wish to refer to the design drawings on pages 55-60 and the Frobel variance on pages 507 of 127 pages. If you need more information, we can get it to you pronto.
- 3. Pages 14-18 (of 127) provide the information regarding the freeboard variance. It has calculations relating to the Pinnacle tanks, which were designed to hold FRESH water. The Rockwater (Poseidon) tanks were designed to hold produced water. Page 81 of 127 has the following text showing the intent to hold produced water.

Geo Pad and Liner

- All tanks setups will require the use of a Rockwater approved underlayment and liner. Typically one 10 ounce, geo
 pad is laid out for added protection and one, 30 mil liner will be placed inside the tank.
- In the event that the tank will be holding produced or recycled water, an extra felt liner (geo pad) should be laid out prior to the AST setup.
- Check customer specifications and regulatory permit liner and containment requirements for ASTs that may hold flowback or produced water.
- 4. I think you have what you need regarding the variance relating to the primary liner system of two 30-mil LLDPE in lieu of one 45-mil LLDPE-R.
