As per our site visit to the Dry Land Shiner Federal #1 on August 28, 2014, COG Operating LLC will excavate within the battery to practical depths depending on depth to rock and infrastructure. Once all excavation is done, Micro Blaze will be applied to the impacted area to promote breakdown of hydrocarbons. The excavation will be left open for a couple

of months during which a second application of Micro Blaze will be applied. At the end of this period, the site will be re-evaluated for remediation progress. Please let me know if you have any questions.
