Please accept this email and the attached C-141 as confirmation of initial notification and initial spill report for a 67 bbl spill (44 recovered) by LPC Crude Oil Marketing, LLC that occurred in Eddy County at N 32° 09' 9.41"; W 103° 43' 38.37" on 11/11/15 at 10:30 PM. This spill from the transport truck occurred on a Devon pad (Cotton Draw 172H) and did not leave the site. A vacuum truck was able to recover 44 bbl of spilled crude oil.

This is the first notification and report of this nature that I've had to make, so if there is any additional information that you need or that I haven't included in the C-141, please contact me so I can provide this information to you. I appreciate your patience as I learn this process.
