As you can see from the attached photos, there is obvious staining on the pad. As shown in photo 12, there does seem to have been a release at some point in that area. There is a visible produced water stain on the pad directly east of the loading area as well as behind my vehicle in photos 15 and 16. While I appreciate stressing to all companies to clean up after themselves, I would like to know what Pyote's plan is to clean up the load line areas as well as the produced water staining that is evident beyond that. Please advise on that as soon as possible.
