 > Your proposal for remediation of the above referenced release is approved with the following conditions and/or notations:
 >
 > Based on available data, ground water may be encountered between 50' and 100' bgs in this area. Vertical depth of impact has not been defined, but the site ranking will be a minimum of 10 points. Representative soil samples are to be obtained not later than 90 days after initial application of MicroBlaze to evaluate progress, and again at 180 days after initial application. If RRAL for the site has not been achieved after 180 days, OCD will require impacted soils to be removed to a disposal.
 >
 > OCD approval does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations fail to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that may pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and/or regulations.
