S1– Excavation to a depth of approximately 4’.

S2 – Excavation to a depth of approximately 2’.

S3- Excavation to a depth of approximately 1’.

All areas excavated were backfilled with like materials. All areas affected during excavation were returned to their normal state and will be reseeded in June of 2017.




