

#### Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

Fire started because of static spark. During flowback operations, a sand storm blew across location. Workers on site heard a loud pop and noticed a flame coming from gas buster tank. Flowback workers shut master valve and evacuated location, but the fire spread to nearby water tanks. Eddy County fire dispatch was notified immediately and extinguished the fire after midnight.

#### Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Fire was contained to well pad. After fire was put out, vacuum trucks recovered 80bbl standing fluid from location. An environmental contractor has been retained to assist with remediation efforts.
