OCD has received your Remediation Plan for STATE 23-1 1RP-5465, thank you. This Remediation Plan is approved with the following <u>Conditions of Approval:</u>

The responsible party will collect confirmation samples per 19.15.29.12 D NMAC to include the <u>sidewalls</u> of the excavation. By Rule <u>19.15.29.12</u> D. CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS:"must test the remediated areas for contamination with representative <u>five point composite samples from the walls and base</u>..."

As we said in a previous correspondence, by Rule NMAC <u>19.15.29.12</u>, for Remediation Plans and/or Closure Reports, the responsible party must submit a document -<u>a single document</u>- that includes:

- 1. Scaled site map diagram with sample points clearly marked
- 2. Photographs of the remediated site prior to backfill
- 3. Confirmation samples analytical results (lab tested)
- 4. Table containing analytical data
- 5. Description of excavation depths corresponding to analytical table
- 6. Depth to groundwater evaluation
- 7. Karst evaluation
- 8. FEMA National Flood map review
- 9. Signed and dated the corresponding part of form C-141
