On December 4, 2019, an estimated release of 15 barrels of crude oil occurred at the Holly Energy Partners (HEP) Abo Centurion Station. Approximately 3 barrels of oil were recovered by vacuum truck and disposed at an NMOCD approved facility. The site is located in Unit Letter F, Section 10, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The NMOCD was notified of the release on December 4, 2019 and the initial C-141 was submitted on December 18, 2019. Following resolution of a technical delay with the NMOCD reporting portal, the approved initial C-141 was received by HEP on January 29, 2020 and the site was assigned the NMOCD Tracking No.: NRM2003032458. A copy of the initial C-141 is attached.

Delineation activities were conducted at the site on December 12, 2019. Laboratory results indicate that further investigation is necessary to complete vertical delineation of TPH and BTEX impacts.

HEP respectfully requests a three month extension (until June 4, 2020) for submittal of the Remediation Workplan to the NMOCD.
