We have received your Workplan/Remediation Proposal for **Incident #NRM1926831738 Marathon Madera Line**, thank you. This Workplan/Remediation proposal is approved with the following conditions:

- Rock resistance was encountered at 2 feet below ground surface, use a hydrovac to remove all of the loose contaminated soil off of the rock at the location (Spill area)
- Please, make sure the horizontal delineation is below the limit of 600 mg/kg for chlorides. The surface samples are all over the limit, except for the two samples southwest of the suspected boundary, further horizontal sampling is needed
