- Are the confirmation samples five-point composite samples?
The stockpile soil samples (STP-1 through STP-3) are five-point composite. However, the confirmation soil samples (CS-1 through CS-18) are grab samples.
- Did you take sidewall samples from the excavation?
Yes
- Please provide more information on the "Remedy Emergency Spill Solution" and the bioremediation process.
Please see the attached Product Specification Sheet for the Remedy Emergency Spill Solution. The bioremediation process of the stockpiles (STP-1 through STP-3) included the application of Remedy with mixing and blending of the piles on a biweekly basis to enhance bioremediation within the stockpiles for reuse on-site.
