Ms. Pitt,

The OCD has approved the Remediation Plan for incident # NRH2003454759 ENRON FEDERAL BATTERY @ O-25-17S-27E 0N 0E with the following conditions of approval:

- The release occurred in a High Karst area, which is considered an unstable area in the spill rule and is subject to the most stringent cleanup levels in Table 1. All five-point confirmation samples -bottom samples and sidewall samples- must meet the closure criteria for this site. Delineation sample EH2 is lightly over limit therefore additional excavation is required in that area. All samples must be representative of 200 square feet or less.
