XTO is requesting an extension for the current deadline of May 5, 2020 for submitting a remediation work plan or closure report required in 19.15.29.12.B.(1) NMAC at Poker Lake Unit 21 Brushy Draw 903H (Incident Number NRM2005160694). The release was discovered February 5, 2020. Drilling operations have been ongoing and to ensure the safety of all personnel and the environment, non-essential personnel are not permitted on site. This has prevented XTO from completing site assessment and remediation work. Regular operational updates will continue to be provided to ensure that work begins as soon as the operations are complete. The most recent update provided by XTO operations stated the drilling was still ongoing. To provide enough time to fully assess the site and conduct remediation work, XTO requests an extension of the deadline until August 5, 2020.
