The OCD has approved the Final C-141 for incident NVV2003741819 FIGHTING OKRA 18 CTB 3 @ D-18-26S-34E. No further action is required at this time and the signed C-141 can be found in the online image data base under the incident #.

**NOTE:** The Depth to groundwater has been incorrectly assessed. When nearby wells are used to determine depth to groundwater, the wells should be no further than ½ mile away from the site, and data should be no more than 25 years old, and well construction information should be provided. However, as this site has been remediate to the most stringent cleanup levels in Table 1, OCD approves this closure request.
