The OCD has denied the submitted Remediation Plan C-141 for incident # NAB1904357971 LANGLEY GETTY COM #002 @ 30-025-32210 1RP-5361 for the following reasons:

- At sample point LG-05, chloride concentration of 38,700 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg), exceeded the closure criteria for this site. More remediation efforts are needed for this site. Please remove as much of the contaminated soil with shovels/hydrovac/hand excavate or any other possible method, before requesting a deferral.
- **The OCD will not close a release, where contaminants are left in place.** A formal deferral request is required if Chevron is looking to complete remediation during any future major well pad construction/alteration or final plugging and abandonment, whichever occurs first.
