This has prevented XTO from initiating site assessment and remediation work. The most recent update provided by the operations team stated the drilling was still ongoing. Operational updates will be provided to ensure that work begins as soon as the operations are complete. To provide enough time to fully assess the site and conduct remediation work concurrently, XTO requests a 90-day extension of the latest deadline until November 5, 2020.
