Your request for an extension to November 3rd, 2020 is approved. XTO is requesting an extension to the current deadline of August 3, 2020, for submitting a remediation work plan, closure report, or deferral request at the Rustler Bluff SWD (Incident Number NRM2004956954), per requirements of 19.15.29.12.B NMAC. The release was discovered on February 3, 2020 and an initial assessment was completed on February 25, 2020. Following the initial assessment, remediation work was conducted by XTO. To date, an estimated 510 cubic yards of impacted soil has been removed. The completion of a remediation work plan or closure report is still pending. As such, XTO requests a 90-day extension of the deadline to November 3, 2020.
