**Rebecca,**

We have received your Workplan/Remediation Proposal for **Incident #NRM2008551917 Tex Mack 11 Fed #118H**, thank you. This Workplan/Remediation proposal is denied.

- Please, make sure a C-141 page 5 "Remediation Plan" page is signed and filled out at submission of your report.
- The spill looks substantially wider than 4'-7' in places, especially up around SP1 and SP2. Need to see at least 8-10 floor samples and sidewall samples. Would like to see 1 additional sample taken in between all linear sample points. Please verify the 2 dark areas south of Sample point SP3 for possible TPH.
- All samples will need to be tested for all components in Table 1 of the spill rule.
