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Mr. Tijerina,

The OCD has denied the submitted Closure Report/Deferral Request C-141 for incident # NRM2010753767 BLUEBERRY SWD @ P-24-21S-33E 0N 0E for the following reasons:

- The Depth to groundwater has been incorrectly assessed. When nearby wells are used to determine depth to groundwater, the wells should be no further than ½ mile away from the site, and data should be no more than 25 years old, and well construction information should be provided. If GOODNIGHT MIDSTREAM PERMIAN, LLC believes that groundwater is > 50', a borehole will need to be drilled onsite and a copy of the driller's log must be provided. Vertical delineation, which is driven by depth to water, is incomplete because the depth to groundwater has not been established.
- It is not clear from Figure 3 "Site & Sample Location Map" if the release reached the off-pad area. In your next submittal, please include an aerial photo (Google map/Google earth) of the facility where the extent of the release is clearly marked. Sample points FS2 and FS2 B are not shown in Figure 3.
