Mr. Dittrich,

Regarding the Conditions of Approval of incident **NRM2005141013** CYPRESS 28 FED 4H @ 30-015-39330, I want to clarify the following:

- The closure report must comply with the Closure Requirements of the spill rule, i.e. 19.15.29.12.D (1)(a), (b), (c)
- Five-point composite confirmation floor samples and sidewall samples, should be collected at a frequency of no more than one sample per 200 square feet.
- Sidewalls samples should not exceed 600 mg/kg for chlorides and 100 mg/kg for TPH.
