We have received your Workplan/Remediation Proposal for <u>Incident #NRM2007645132</u> Edith Federal #1, thank you. This Workplan/Remediation proposal is approved with the following conditions:

- Samples inside berm area must be resampled after bioremediation treatment occurs in 90 days. Samples must be taken every 200 ft2 from surface down to 3 feet in (1 foot increments). All samples will need to verify that they are <600 mg/kg for chlorides and <100 mg/kg for TPH.
- Sample S5 is outside the berm and will need to be excavated down to the first clean sample point (4 feet below ground surface). A sidewall sample will be required on the south side of the excavation of <100 mg/kg (TPH) for lateral delineation.
- Sample S6 is above the limit for TPH (100 mg/kg) at 4 feet below ground surface and needs further delineation/excavation.
