Ms. Garza,

The OCD has denied the submitted Closure Report C-141 for incident # NRM2014958679 SANDY FEDERAL BATTERY @ P-23-23S-30E ON OE for the following reasons:

- The Depth to groundwater has been incorrectly assessed. The remediation levels outlined in Table 1 of 19.15.29.12 NMAC have not been established for this site.
- Confirmation samples must be analyzed for the constituents listed in Table 1; see Closure Requirements: 19.15.29.12.D.1,(a), (b), (c).
- According to the Site Characterization/Remediation Plan, the spill encompasses approximately the entire well pad. The entire affected area needs to be delineated and remediated per rule 19.15.29.11 & 19.15.29.12.
- Liner installation requires a variance. The variance request must include a detailed statement explaining the need for a variance and a detailed written demonstration that the variance will provide equal or better protection of fresh water, public health, and the environment.
