

Per our discussion today, BP Pipeline Company plans to disconnect its pipeline gathering system from the following leases in Eddy County, NM:

The leases will be disconnected from BP Pipeline's Dagger Draw Gathering System effective June 1, 2004. They are being disconnected because of low volume (ineffective scraper runs) and the problems they cause up stream when they are being injected into the line. We appreciated the opportunity to have provided pipeline transportation and regret that circumstances dictate that this service be disconnected. Per my discussion with Kris Baxter, the operator has been notified of the disconnects.
