Lightning struck tank causing a chain reaction fire which spread to adjacent tanks. Fire department called and responded. Fire extinguished and small amount of free standing fluid outside of berm contained. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Majority of fluid which escaped tanks which did not burn was contained within the bermed area around the tanks. This fluid was recovered by vaccum truck in the quantities reflected above. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe. Such a hearing may result in imposition of <u>CIVIL PENALTIES</u> for your violation of OCD rules.
