
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Spill was caused by a flowline leak. A vacuum truck was used to pick up fluids. Highlander Environmental Corp. was contacted to assess and remediate the site.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The original spill area measured approximately 18' x 100'. Highlander supervised the removal of 4'-5' of impacted soil from the spill area. This soil was taken to Sundance Services for disposal. Trenches and boreholes were placed to define the vertical limits of chloride impact. The site was capped with 40 mil plastic and backfilled.
