Diana:

The test performed on July 1, 2004 was a MIT (Casing integrity test) not a bradenhead test. I was unable to perform a test of the bradenhead since it was not plumbed to the surface, therefore was not visible. I informed the company representative on location that the cellar must be dug out and the bradenhead plumbed to a position above the surface of the location so it may be tested and monitored. This was the reason for the violation (copy attached).

Please advise me 48 hours prior to the date you are ready for re-inspection. This date must be prior to placing the well on injection.
