Procedure to Plug and Abandon

1. Set CTBP @ 2100' and dump bail 35' of cement on top.
2. Spot cement plug from 800' to 900'. (20 sx)
3. Isolate leak in 4 1/2" casing.
4. Cement squeeze hole in 4 1/2" casing per BLM. (Call Alexis Swoboda @ 505-627-0272 for procedure.) Tag cement plug.
5. Spot cement plug from 310' to 410' and tag. (20 sx)
6. Spot cement plug from 50' to surface. (20 sx)

Note: Fill hole w/ 9.5 ppg mud laden fluid
