It is suspected the issue was a result of bad weather as storms had passed through recently. Issues regarding the alarm system are being researched.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The 30BBLS of produced water that spilled from the water tank all spilled into lined containment. All 30BBLS were recovered. No further action is required.
