In order to address Compliance Oder 04-074-11W the pit re-cap work is scheduled to start on 11/13/11 as out lined below. During the preliminary excavation activities a total of thirteen excavation samples were concluded and all excavated soils were similar reddish brown, mostly fine grain and moist below +/- eighteen inches. There was no evidence of hydrocarbon staining in any of the thirteen excavations

- Guiding the excavation contractor to the pit area and give instructions on field expectations for the pit re-cap restoration activities. Daily safety meetings will be conducted by the BHPB site supervisor and contractor.
- Place a barrier around the pit area to prevent damage to the existing surrounding vegetation.
- Excavate and transport for disposal, to the Gandy-Marley landfill, approximately eighteen to twenty four inches of soil, liner and other materials. The amount of materials to be removed and disposed is approximately 900 to 1200 cubic yards.
- A 20 mil cap liner would then be installed to replace the existing cap liner. The cap liner will be keyed in with a one foot deep trench along the edges of the pit to assure its placement.
- Soil will be placed on the liner to return the pit area to the adjacent grade. The area will be topped with another foot of soil that is conducive to promoting vegetative growth.
- Reseeding to BLM specifications will be done in the spring of 2012 and the area will be fenced to allow seed growth.
- Per the request of the Land Owner the caliche road that provides access to the pit area will not be removed.
