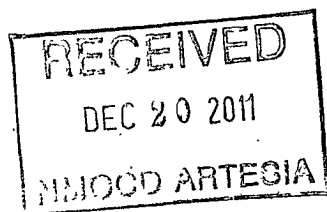

Conditions of Approval**

- 1. In place of CIBP at 6,932', operator shall set a cement plug across the top of the Bone Spring formation and over the perforations in this request. Pursuant to the completion report, the top of the Bone Spring lime is at 7146'. Operator shall set a Class C cement plug, minimum of 25 sacks, from cement on top of CIBP at 7238' to 6890'. Plug shall be tagged at 6890' or shallower. Contact 575-361-2822 for BLM witness of tag. Failure to meet this COA will result in an Incidence of Non-Compliance.**
- 2. Surface disturbance beyond the originally approved pad must have prior approval.**
- 3. Closed loop system required.**
- 4. A minimum of a 2M BOP is required and must be tested prior to performing operations.**
- 5. Subsequent sundry required.**
- 6. Work to be completed in 90 days.**
