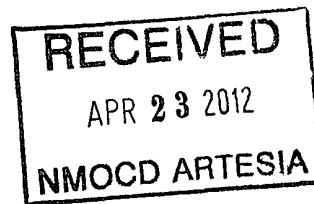

1. Notify BLM 575-361-2822 Eddy Co. before beginning work. The casing test are to be witnessed. Note the contact, time, & date in your subsequent report.
2. **Should the casing be altered (replaced), prior BLM approval will be necessary.**
3. **Provide BLM with an electronic copy (Adobe Acrobat Document) cement bond log record. Less than 500ft between the proposed top perforation and top of cement or lack of a 500ft overlap above next casing shoe may require correction. The CFO BLM engineer may be reached at 575-234-5972 during business hours and 575-706-2779 after hours.**
4. Surface disturbance beyond the existing pad must have prior approval.
5. A closed loop system is required. The operator shall properly dispose of drilling/circulating contents at an authorized disposal site. Tanks are required for all operations, no excavated pits.
6. H<sub>2</sub>S monitoring equipment to be used on location and functional.
7. A 2000 (2M) BOP/BOPE to be used. All blowout preventer (BOP) and related equipment (BOPE) shall comply with reasonable well control requirements. A two ram system with a blind ram and a pipe ram designed for the work string shall be adequate. Tapered work strings will require an additional pipe ram.
8. All waste (i.e. trash, salts, chemicals, sewage, gray water, etc.) created as a result of work over operations shall be safely contained and disposed of properly at a waste disposal facility. No waste material or fluid shall be disposed of on the well location or surrounding area. Porto-johns and trash containers will be on-location during fracturing operations or any other crew-intensive operations.
9. Workover approval is good for 90 days (completion to be within 90 days of approval). A legitimate request is necessary for extension of that date.
