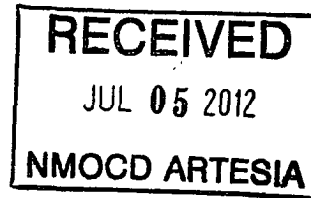

Gentlemen:

Our letter of June 8, 2012 stated that your Application for Permit to Drill (APD), approved December 16, 2008 for two years for the McKay B Federal Well No. 4, located 1650 feet FNL and 400 feet FEL (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Sec. 33, T. 5 S., R. 21 E., Chaves County, New Mexico, Federal lease NM-36189 has expired. The expiration of this APD is rescinded because drilling had commenced at the location for the McKay B Federal Well No. 4 under the name of Eppers B Federal Well No. 2 on August 14, 2008 and the well was drilled to a total depth of 2800 feet on November 11, 2008. The well is currently considered to be in Drilling Well-Shut In (DSI) status and the status will be changed after the Well Completion Report (BLM Form 3160-4) and any necessary Sundry Reports (BLM Form 3160-5) are received by this office.
