

Dear Mr. Arrant:

We are in receipt of your letter dated June 5, 2012 concerning an APD for a gas well 150' FNL & 660' FWL of Section 36, T-23-S, R-30-E. Mosaic Potash Carlsbad Inc. does have a potash lease 150 feet north of this location.

Your request is to drill the Los Medanos 36 23 30 State 1H test well to the Bone Springs formation and therefore a "deep gas well" according to the OCD definition. Mosaic Potash's LMR as designated in accordance with NMOCC Order R-111-P encompasses an area within ¼ mile to the NNE of this location. This well's ½ mile buffer would impact a substantial quantity of potash reserve. Mosaic objects to the location of this well for this reason.

As more information becomes available, our estimates of the extent of potash resources in any given area may change. If you are still considering these well locations at a date later than one year from today, notify us again at that time so we can make a new decision on information current at that time. Do not consider a "no objection offered" or an "objection offered" decision to be permanent.
