Specific Reference: Excavation to remediate produced fluids release due to below grade fiberglass tank leak.

Operator,

A letter dated July 5, 2005 requesting closure of the above referenced excavation has been received by the NMOCD District 2 office. The request to close the excavation is approved with the following stipulations:

- 1. As agreed, a 1 foot compacted clay barrier will be installed on bottom of excavation.
- 2. Notify NMOCD District 2 office 24 hours prior to installation of barrier to allow OCD personnel the opportunity to witness.
- 3. A plastic liner and berm be utilized if storage vessel is to be installed on point of excavation.

The above approval applies to the excavation only. Other concerns to be addressed at this site are as follows:

- 1. The area where the contaminated soil was stockpiled is to be tested for contaminants and remediated as necessary.
- 2. As per BLM request, the location size and number of roads leading into location is to be reduced and area reclaimed to support vegetation.
- 3. Submit a "Final Report" C-141 outlining work performed upon completion of all activities at this site.
- 4. Work is to be completed and site ready for final inspection no later than August 15, 2005.

Be advised that acceptance or approval of a C-141, closure request, or remediation work plan does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, NMOCD acceptance or approval of a C-141, closure request, or remediation work plan does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and or regulations.

The rest of the area will be scraped and cleaned for a miform look to the location.
