The NMOCD District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of a Closure Proposal prepared and submitted by your agent, Environmental Plus Inc. for a produced fluids release that occurred at the above referenced well site on June 9, 2005. The document submitted proposes to remediate site at time of tank battery decommission.

According to available ground water information for this area, the well site is situated in a water sensitive area. The proposal to leave contaminates in place for any length of time is denied.

An inspection of the site by OCD personnel on 9/13/05 shows that area appears to have had recent releases, possibly after initial excavation at site. (Photos enclosed)

At this time, the OCD is requesting the following:

Equipment be repaired or replaced to minimize the possibility of continued and future releases at this site.

Site is to be delineated for vertical and horizontal extent of contamination and type and levels of contaminants present.
