Newly drilled & completed Peak View well # 2 unloaded csg, exceeding production treater capacity causing excess fluid & pressure to exit through the PSV. A choke valve was installed on the Peak View well # 2 csg.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

36'X150' & 36'X135' of damp caliche production btry pad, & 1.5'X885' of damp sandy pasture. The fluid was picked up by a vacuum truck and 42 cu yds of contaminated soil was scraped from the caliche battery pad with 51.74 tons of Base Course caliche spread in the scraped area. The spill site was sampled & delineated, and a remediation plan was submitted to and approved by the NMOCD.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
