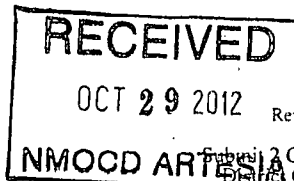

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* The gun barrel tank overflowed at the SWD facility due to the fact that the alarm has not been installed yet. Alarms will be installed on the oil tanks to prevent re-occurrence.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Initially 15bbls were released from the overflowed gun barrel and we were able to recover 12bbls with a vacuum truck. The fluid ran into the lined facility and was contained by the dike walls. All free fluid has been recovered and the contaminated gravel has been removed. The tanks and the liner have been steam cleaned and fresh gravel has been replaced into the SWD. The facility has been returned to its prior condition.
