

Bleeder valve was left open on filter pot after the water pump had been serviced. Shut the valve to prevent further release.					
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*					
Initially 100bbls of produced water were released due to the filter pot valve being left after the water pump was serviced. We were able to recover 99bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was completely contained in a lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned, and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This facility has been returned to its prior condition.
