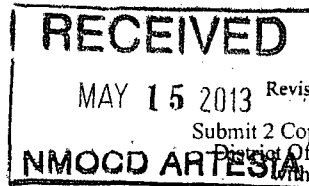

The casing valve was left open on the well head. Closed the valve to prevent any further release.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 40bbls of oil were released from an open casing valve on the well head. We were able to recover 30bbls of oil with a vacuum truck. The spill occurred on the location and traveled to the adjacent pasture. All free fluids have been removed from the location and the pasture. A work plan will be presented to the NMOC for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
