Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* <b>The murphy switch malfunctioned and did not turn on the transfer pump. We have replaced the murphy switch to prevent recurrence.</b>		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* <b>Initially 10bbls of produced water were released due to a murphy switch failure on the water tank. We were able to recover 7bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was completely contained inside the facility walls. All free fluid has been recovered. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.</b>
