

Initially 20bbls were released from the oil tank due to a closed equalizing line. We were able to recover 19bbls with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluids have been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been washed, and we have replaced with clean gravel as necessary. This facility has been returned to its prior condition.
