

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*  
A hole in the bottom of a 4" production occurred due to corrosion. The line has been replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
Initially 3bbls oil and 12bbls of produced water were released to a corroded 4" line. We were able to recover 3bbls of oil and 11bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluids have been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been washed, and we have replaced with clean gravel as necessary. This facility has been returned to its prior condition.
