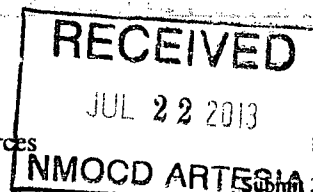

Transducer malfunctioned due to rain collecting in conduit. Causing the transfer pump not to run, over flowing the water tank.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Initially 2bbls of oil and 20bbls of produced water were released from the water tank we were able to recover 2bbls of oil and 19bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluids have been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been washed, and we have replaced with clean gravel as necessary. This facility has been returned to its prior condition.
