

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A ¼ bleeder valve on the circulating pump opened causing the release. Replaced the bleeder valve with a new one.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 24bbbls of oil were released due to an ¼ bleeder valve that failed. We were able to recover 20bbbls with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Contaminated gravel has been removed and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
