

Gasket on FWKO (free water knock-out) leaked. FWKO was isolated and used a vacuum truck to recover standing fluids.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
Majority of spill was contained inside lined facility, with a 200'x200' overspray area on the pad, and a 100'x100' overspray area in the pasture. Pad area has been scraped and the impacted soil will be hauled to disposal, pasture area will be micro-blazed to neutralize hydrocarbons.
