

Vic seal ring leak due to bad check valve. Replace check valve.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
Initially 34bbbls of produced water were released from the filter pot inside the tank inside. We were able to recover 20bbbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
