

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Truck driver switched production tank and shut equalizer lines and tank ran over. Driver not to shut equalizer lines.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Initially 30bbls of oil were released from the oil tank running over. We were able to recover 20bbls of oil with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
