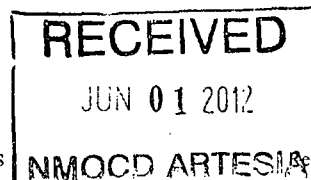

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*: Fluid was released on slop and flowed down hill for approximately 1650 ft. following an arroyo. The spill was approximately 2 ft wide. Remedial action pending.
