The water production for the day was three times the normal production; it is suspected that produced water was unloaded into the water storage tanks from an unknown source. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*								
The spill impacted an area of approximately 900 sq.ft. inside the tank batteries earthen containment. There is a remediation underway at the facility dealing with an unauthorized release on the well pad and reserve pit. The affected area in the pasture will be remediated in accordance to the NMOCD guidelines.
