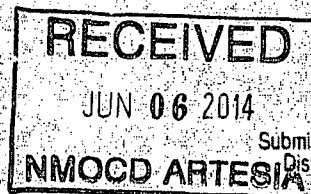

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A 4" waterline going from the heater treater and the FWKO to the water tanks developed a leak. We replaced the 4" steel line with a new joint.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 40bbls of produced water were released. We were able to recover 40bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we has replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
